Resolution 16-11

Authority Member REEVES moved approval of the following resolution:

A RESOLUTION HONORING KIM BOYD OF THE COLORADO SPRINGS POLICE DEPARTMENT, AS TELECOMMUNICATOR OF THE THIRD QUARTER 2016.

WHEREAS, the El Paso – Teller County Emergency Telephone Service Authority was created to provide a two-county-wide E9-1-1 system; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Authority wish to recognize outstanding call takers and dispatchers within the system through the Telecommunicator of the Quarter and Telecommunicator of the Year programs; and

WHEREAS, On September 16, 2016 Public Safety Dispatcher Kim Boyd worked a TEU warrant for a wanted suspect out of the El Paso County Sheriff's Department. Before the warrant could be served on the house, the suspect left the location in a vehicle. CSPD got into a pursuit with the suspect. The suspect had no regard for the safety of the officers or any citizen that might be in his path.

WHEREAS, At one point, the suspect rammed through a fence at the dead-end of a cul-de-sac and continued on his path. Eventually the suspect abandoned his damaged vehicle and fled on foot. After 4 ½ hours of tracking, CSPD received a 911 hang-up call from a female party who could not speak freely. PSD Kim Boyd recognized the address and utilized her situational awareness to recognize this address as the one that had been searched earlier for a possible suspect sighting.

WHEREAS, PSD Kim Boyd immediately acted and dispatched officers to the area where the suspect was shot and detained. The citizen who called 911 was rescued and not harmed. Due to the effective dispatching and situational awareness of PSD Kim Boyd, no officers were harmed and the citizen's life was saved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

The El Paso – Teller County Enhanced 9-1-1 Authority honors Kim Boyd as the Telecommunicator of the Third Quarter of 2016.
