A RESOLUTION HONORING BRENNA POGOY OF THE COLORADO SPRINGS POLICE DEPARTMENT AS TELECOMMUNICATOR OF THE THIRD QUARTER 2019.

WHEREAS, the El Paso – Teller County Emergency Telephone Service Authority was created to provide a two-county-wide 9-1-1 system; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Authority wish to recognize outstanding call takers and dispatchers within the system through the Telecommunicator of the Quarter and Telecommunicator of the Year programs; and

WHEREAS, Brenna Pogoy received a 911 call from a female whispering on the line. Although the caller was in danger she was able to provide her address and her name. She told Brenna that she had overheard the suspects planning to rape and kill her. Brenna was able to gather information by having the caller answer yes or no questions, then by tapping on the phone. Brenna never hesitated to send this caller help. Brenna did not doubt the information she was given and used her intuition and call processing skills to provide vital information to the officers to ensure the safety of the caller.

WHEREAS, The suspects were taken into custody along with several bags of meth and weapons. The victim was transported to Memorial Hospital to receive the medical care she needed.

WHEREAS, Brenna Pogoy showed her professionalism and expertise processing this call and should be recognized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

The El Paso – Teller County 9-1-1 Authority honors Brenna Pogoy as Telecommunicator of the Third Quarter of 2019.




