WHEREAS, Miles De Young donated many hours as a volunteer member of the Authority; and

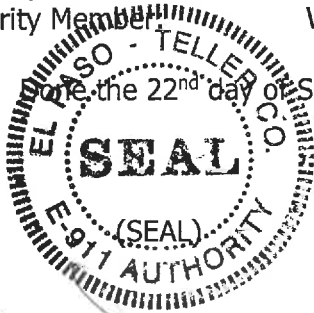
WHEREAS, Miles De Young's skills and abilities have assisted in the smooth operation of the 9-1-1 system.
