A RESOLUTION HONORING LISA SCHNEIDER OF THE FOUNTAIN COMMUNICATIONS DEPARTMENT, AS TELECOMMUNICATOR OF THE FOURTH QUARTER OF 2013.

**WHEREAS**, the El Paso – Teller County Emergency Telephone Service Authority was created to provide a two-county-wide E9-1-1 system; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the Authority wish to recognize outstanding call takers and dispatchers within the system through the Telecommunicator of the Quarter and Telecommunicator of the Year programs; and

**WHEREAS**, Lisa received a call on Friday, November 1, 2013 at 0458. Lisa was working in the communications center by herself when she received the 911 call for a 30 year old female in labor. In the Fountain Communications center when you are by yourself it is not an easy task when taking even the basic medical call. A child birth call makes the task even harder when supplying pre-arrival instructions. Lisa was able to start down the proper path and dispatch the Fire Department to the scene.

**WHEREAS**, the call progressed then progressed from a female having contractions 2 minutes apart to delivery. Lisa proceeded down the path for child birth while still giving information over the radio to responding units. Lisa's knowledge and command of the protocol was paramount in the success of the call and to the safety of the mother and baby. Lisa's quick thinking and amazing multi-tasking skills make her a credit to the system and to the people that she serves.

Authority Member GOMES seconded the adoption of the foregoing resolution. The roll having been called, the vote was as follows:


