Authority Member ANSTINE moved approval of the following resolution:

A RESOLUTION HONORING JAY BARDELL OF THE FORT CARSON FIRE DEPARTMENT, AS TELECOMMUNICATOR OF THE THIRD QUARTER OF 2013.

WHEREAS, the El Paso – Teller County Emergency Telephone Service Authority was created to provide a two-county-wide E9-1-1 system; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Authority wish to recognize outstanding call takers and dispatchers within the system through the Telecommunicator of the Quarter and Telecommunicator of the Year programs; and

WHEREAS, On July 31, 2013, the Fort Carson 911 center received multiple, simultaneous police and fire incident calls. Mr. Bardell was a new employee with only few weeks on the job when within approximately 20 minutes, there was a mass casualty from a lightning strike resulting in 12 patients, a person trapped in an elevator, a security incident at a gate, a fire alarm, traffic stops and a drug call to name a few. This was a highly stressful and exceptionally complex period of time.

WHEREAS, Mr. Bardell played a pivotal role in assuring all calls were answered and processed appropriately. He made appropriate notifications and updates without being directed and gave the impression he has been in this profession for years. His notifications, coordination and updates to responding air, medical and field units were spot on. His attention to detail and exceptional follow through made a difference in the lives of the soldiers, civilians and families involved.

The El Paso – Teller County Enhanced 9-1-1 Authority honors Jay Bardell as the Telecommunicator of the Third Quarter, 2013.
