WHEREAS, the El Paso – Teller County Emergency Telephone Service Authority was created to provide a two-county-wide 9-1-1 system; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Authority wish to recognize outstanding call takers and dispatchers within the system through the Telecommunicator of the Quarter and Telecommunicator of the Year programs; and

WHEREAS, During an October nightshift at Cripple Creek Police Department, Kim Bursack's partner wasn't feeling well and went home sick. Suddenly, from the hallway, Kim heard her partner whisper, "I think I'm going to have a seizure." As she began to fall, Kim rushed to her, laid her on the floor and moved dangerous objects as she went into a grand mal seizure.

WHEREAS, Kim had to return to dispatch due to steady call volume, she also toned out medical and police. Kim could see her partner and returned to her as often as possible between calls for service. When the seizure was over Kim checked for breathing and started to turn her on her side but she went into another seizure.

WHEREAS, Corporal Galbreath arrived to help and was impressed by Kim's calmness, how she provided first aid and continued to provide calls for service. Kim is a great team player and demonstrated superior performance during a very stressful time.




