A RESOLUTION HONORING SUE ARAGON, FROM THE FORT CARSON DIRECTORATE OF EMERGENCY SERVICE, AS TELECOMMUNICATOR OF THE THIRD QUARTER OF 2014.

**WHEREAS**, the El Paso – Teller County Emergency Telephone Service Authority was created to provide a two-county-wide E9-1-1 system; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the Authority wish to recognize outstanding call takers and dispatchers within the system through the Telecommunicator of the Quarter and Telecommunicator of the Year programs; and

**WHEREAS**, On May 17, 2014, at 2208 hours, Sue took a pregnancy call where the baby was delivering. She did a phenomenal job of keeping the caller (the father), calm and delivered instructions from the protocol perfectly, keeping him focused on the task at hand until units arrived on scene to transport a brand new baby boy and healthy mom to Evans Hospital.

**WHEREAS**, On July 25, 2014, at 1246 hours, Sue took a difficulty breathing call. During the course of the call, it was reported that the patient had stopped breathing. Sue was immediately into the DLS protocols and giving CPR instructions. The instructions were read flawlessly and when Sue realized the caller's pace on chest compressions were a little slow, she began calling out a cadence to help the caller keep the proper pace. The patient was resuscitated not once but twice during the call. Sue did a great job of keeping the caller calm and on task. She was given an exemplary performance report on the call.

**WHEREAS**, Sue is setting high standards for her peers and is truly a valued member of the team.
